

Your electrical contractor will understand **ALL** legal requirements of connection before undertaking any work or installation.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES UNDERTAKE THIS YOURSELF

Note for electrician:

- 1) Connect within current laws and IP directives.
- 2) (Preferred) Wire into isolated fused feed connecting directly to the house consumer/service box.

Always use protection against electrical surge. Your shower should be treated the same as a home computer. A surge protector should eradicate the possibility of burn out.

Subject to connection type, electrical work needs to be signed off by a fully qualified operative by law. Failure to adhere to this will not only void your electrical warranty for your sauna, but could void your house insurance.






Step 1 — Placing the two back panels into position



Step 2 — Bench side upright Install





Step 3 — Installing the bench tops




Step 4 — **Installing bench panels**

Rotate the front of the bench slightly and slot it up into position.







Step 5 — Installing fixed glass panels




Step 6 — Installing the door




8x 40mm Screws—Place 2 screws in each joint







Step 7 — Door Handle



Step 8 — Roof Installation


The roof slots into position








Step 8 — Installing the heater and heater guard




8x 40mm Screws




Slot together and secure with screws.

Place heater in position







Step 9 — **Installing the temperature guage**



2x 40mm Screws

Screw the backplate into position then slot the gauge into the backplate







Insert the rocks into the heater. Place smaller rocks between the heating elements and the larger rocks on top.

Now the Sauna is assembled, take the wooden dowels and insert over any screw to give the Sauna a sleek and neat finish.

Step 8 — Connecting the power





Bluetooth connectivity:

Press the audio function button (8) until the display reads 'bt' and the Sauna will search for a Bluetooth device. If previously paired, your device and Sauna will sync together and you can begin playing music. To pair, search in your phone for Bluetooth devices and pair with the Sauna.

Control Panel Instructions

Button 1/2 (Temperature)

Use the plus and minus buttons to change the temperature your sauna will reach.

Button 3/4 (Time)

Use the plus and minus buttons to change the duration of the sauna session, until the heaters automatically shut off.

Button 5 (Memory)

Use this button the play or pause the USB, Bluetooth or Radio audio.

Button 6 (Lights)

Press once for roof light on. Press twice for roof light off and wall lights on. Press three times for roof lights on and wall lights on. Press four times to turn all lights off.

Button 7 (Sauna)

Use this button to start the heaters for the sauna session

Button 8 (Audio function)

Use to toggle between radio, Bluetooth and USB audio preferences

Button 9/10 (Mode)

Use to change the volume, the music tack or radio station

Button 11 (Power)

Use to power the control panel on or off.

Radio Station Tuning

Press the Memory button (5) for 3 seconds after the audio frequency flashes then press again to automatically search. Once this process has been completed, stations will be automatically saved in their designated positions.



BEFORE FIRST USE — IMPORTANT

- 1. Ensure the rocks have been thoroughly washed before loading in to the heater.
- 2. Ensure you place the rocks loosely between the heating elements.
- 3. Don't over fill the heater, ensure sufficient airflow can be achieved for maximum output.
- 4. **START UP!** It's recommended that you heat the rocks thoroughly and leave the sauna door closed for a period of 30-40 minutes. The rocks being new may split or spit under the heat as they settle in. This is normal, but we recommend you don't sit in the cabin until you have run the heat through the rocks and they have settled in. You may want to turn the heater off and perform this a second time (when the rocks have cooled down) to be 100% certain they have settled in.
- 5. It's recommended that the rocks are replaced annually and only use approved Sauna rocks,

 NEVER use any other type of rock.
- 6. Never touch the rocks when they are fully heated.
- 7. Pour a ladle of water over the rocks approx. every 5 minutes to increase the air temperature.
- 8. Pouring too much water on the rocks will lower the room temperature as they will cause the rocks to cool down.
- 9. Never leave the Sauna unattended.
- 10. Children should not use the Sauna unsupervised.

Sauna Usage & Safety Guide

- 1. When you turn it on, you **MUST** pour water over the rocks as it's the vapour that creates the heat not the rocks. The rocks alone will never heat up the sauna. Failure to do this could cause the rocks to split and break
- 2. Never leave children unattended in the Sauna.
- 3. Regulate the temperature of sauna before session Pre-heat time 15-30 minutes (from room temperature 20c)
- 4. Never touch the heater panels whilst in operation, possible burning may occur.
- 5. Recommended time of use is a maximum of 15 mins. We highly recommend working up in time to this, beginning with 5 minute sessions to get your body used to using a sauna.
- 6. Stay hydrated during each Sauna session.
- 7. Exit the sauna immediately if feeling dizzy, faint or short of breath.
- 8. Do NOT use the sauna if you're pregnant, have a heart condition, have low or high blood pressure. If you're unsure consult your GP before use.
- 9. If you have any underlying health conditions which you feel could be aggravated by an increase in temperature, consult your GP before use.
- 10. If you begin to have any issues with your health after using a sauna, stop immediately and consult your GP regarding your symptoms before continuing to use.
- 11. Consult your GP before using the sauna room if you're on medication at all, especially with drowsy side effects.
- 12. Never use this sauna if you have been drinking alcohol or under the influence of other substances.
- 13. Do not put combustible material on the heaters at any time.
- 14. Always turn power supply off after use.

WEEE Compliance Statement




