Note for electrician:

1) Connect within current laws and IP directives.

2) (Preferred) Wire into isolated fused feed connecting directly to the house consumer/service box.

Always use protection against electrical surge. Your shower should be treated the same as a home computer. A surge protector should eradicate the possibility of burn out.

Subject to connection type, electrical work needs to be signed off by a fully qualified operative by law. Failure to adhere to this will not only void your electrical warranty for your sauna, but could void your house insurance







Step 1 — Placing the base and the left back panel in position






Step 2 — Connecting the right back panel to the left back panel




Step 3 — Installing long bench heater




Step 4 — Installing the long seat

Slide the top of the seat into position, resting on the wooden struts.





Step 5 — Installing short bench heater




Step 6 — Installing the short seat


Slide the top of the seat into position, resting on the wooden struts.






Step 7 — **Installing the side bench blocks**








Step 8 — Connecting the door and fixed glass panels




Align the connection (left) located along the door and the front fixed glass panels. Slot together and push the fixed glass panels down for a secure connection.









Step 8 — Installing the door and fixed glass panels to the back panels
















Now the Sauna is assembled, take the wooden dowels and insert over any screw to give the Sauna a sleek and neat finish.

Step 8 — Connecting the power





Bluetooth connectivity:

Press the audio function button (8) until the display reads 'bt' and the Sauna will search for a Bluetooth device. If previously paired, your device and Sauna will sync together and you can begin playing music. To pair, search in your phone for Bluetooth devices and pair with the Sauna.

Control Panel Instructions

Button 1/2 (Temperature)

Use the plus and minus buttons to change the temperature your sauna will reach.

Button 3/4 (Time)

Use the plus and minus buttons to change the duration of the sauna session, until the heaters automatically shut off.

Button 5 (Memory)

Use this button the play or pause the USB, Bluetooth or Radio audio.

Button 6 (Lights)

Press once for roof light on. Press twice for roof light off and wall lights on. Press three times for roof lights on and wall lights on. Press four times to turn all lights off.

Button 7 (Sauna)

Use this button to start the heaters for the sauna session

Button 8 (Audio function)

Use to toggle between radio, Bluetooth and USB audio preferences

Button 9/10 (Mode)

Use to change the volume, the music tack or radio station

Button 11 (Power)

Use to power the control panel on or off.

Radio Station Tuning

Press the Memory button (5) for 3 seconds after the audio frequency flashes then press again to automatically search. Once this process has been completed, stations will be automatically saved in their designated positions.

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Sauna Usage & Safety Guide

- 1. Never leave children unattended in the Sauna.
- 2. Regulate the temperature of sauna before session Pre-heat time 15-30 minutes (from room temperature 20c)
- 3. Never touch the heater panels whilst in operation, possible burning may occur.
- 4. Recommended time of use 15-20 minutes per session
- 5. Stay hydrated during each Sauna session.
- 6. Exit the sauna immediately if feeling dizzy, faint or short of breath.
- 7. Do NOT use the sauna if you're pregnant, have a heart condition, have low or high blood pressure. If you're unsure consult your GP before use.
- 8. If you have any underlying health conditions which you feel could be aggravated by an increase in temperature, consult your GP before use.
- 9. If you begin to have any issues with your health after using a sauna, stop immediately and consult your GP regarding your symptoms before continuing to use.
- 10. Consult your GP before using the steam room if you're on medication at all, especially with drowsy side effects.
- 11. Never use this sauna if you have been drinking alcohol or under the influence of other substances.
- 12. Do not put combustible material on the heaters at any time.
- 13. Always turn power supply off after use.


WEEE Compliance Statement


